Proposed Scope of Practice for a Podiatry Limited License

I have worked out the scope of practice guidelines you requested for the limited podiatry license. Limited Podiatry License would include the following:

- 1. Debridement and or removal of toenails.
- 2. Incision/drainage of abscess-superficial.
- 3. Incision/removal foreign bodies-superficial.
- 4. Paring of callosities hard or soft.
- 5. Treatment of Verrucca by any means.
- 6. Wound care excluding bone, tendons and connective tissue.
- 7. Non-complicated fracture treatment. Fractures that can be treated with casting in the office. No fixation involved.
- 8. Excision of identified or unidentifiable superficial skin lesions.
- 9. Injection(s) of local anesthesia and steroids for the treatment of inflammatory soft tissue diseases.
- 10. Injection of sclerosing agents for soft tissue diseases.

I believe these ten areas will cover 95% of the office based problems a busy surgical podiatrist would need help with in the office. I also believe they are restrictive enough to deter podiatrists who intend to slip into Nevada to only perform foot surgery or worse.
